*Title:* Embracing Revenge and Three Notions of Consequence

*Abstract:* Recently, Roy T Cook, Philippe Schlenker, and Nicholas Tourville have developed a many-valued approach to semantic paradox and the revenge problem known as the Embracing Revenge view. This account involves an indefinitely extensible hierarchy of increasingly expressive languages, and a semantics that includes a corresponding hierarchy of transfinitely many truth values. In this talk I will explore three distinct ways to construct a deductive system within this approach - one based on reading the additional semantic values as (or analogous to) 'gaps', one based on reading them as (or as analogous to) 'gluts', and one based on reading them as analogous to degrees of truth.
